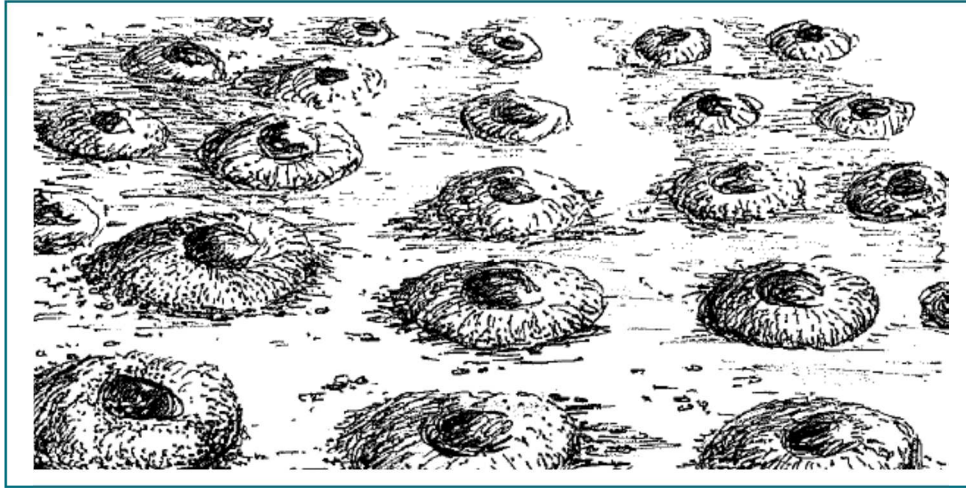


Ploegvore (pitting)

Type and Scale(s)

Catch, hold and use.
Can be done by hand on a small scale for crops.

Scales 1 and 2

Description and Purpose

Digging many small, shallow pits or "imprints" in the soil that collect rainwater runoff, seed, sediment and plant litter. Provide small sheltered areas in which seeds and seedlings can grow.
